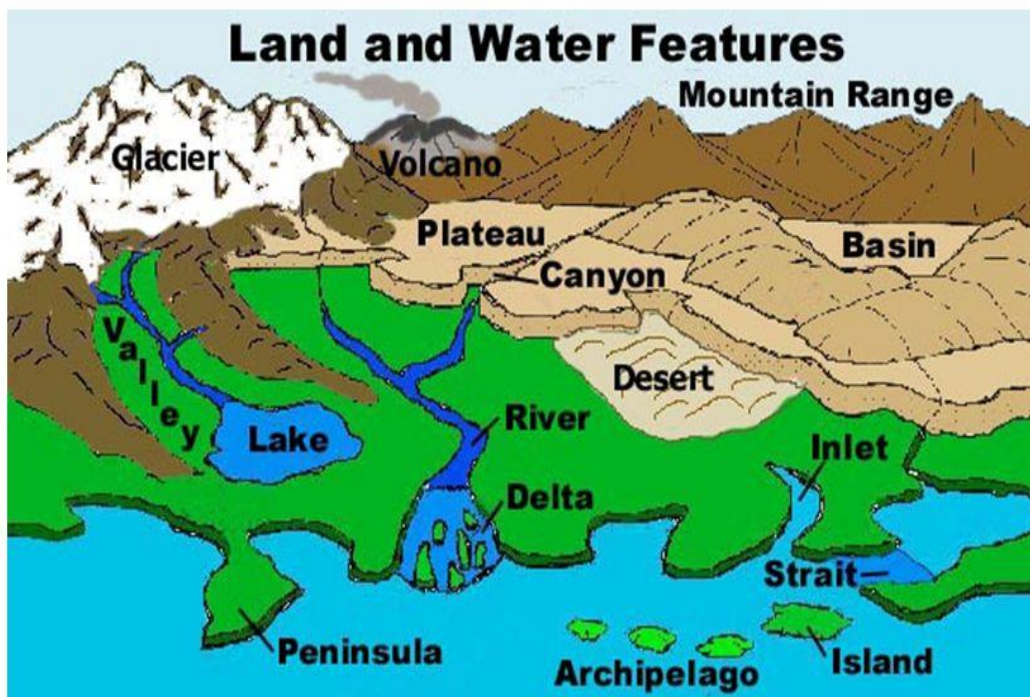

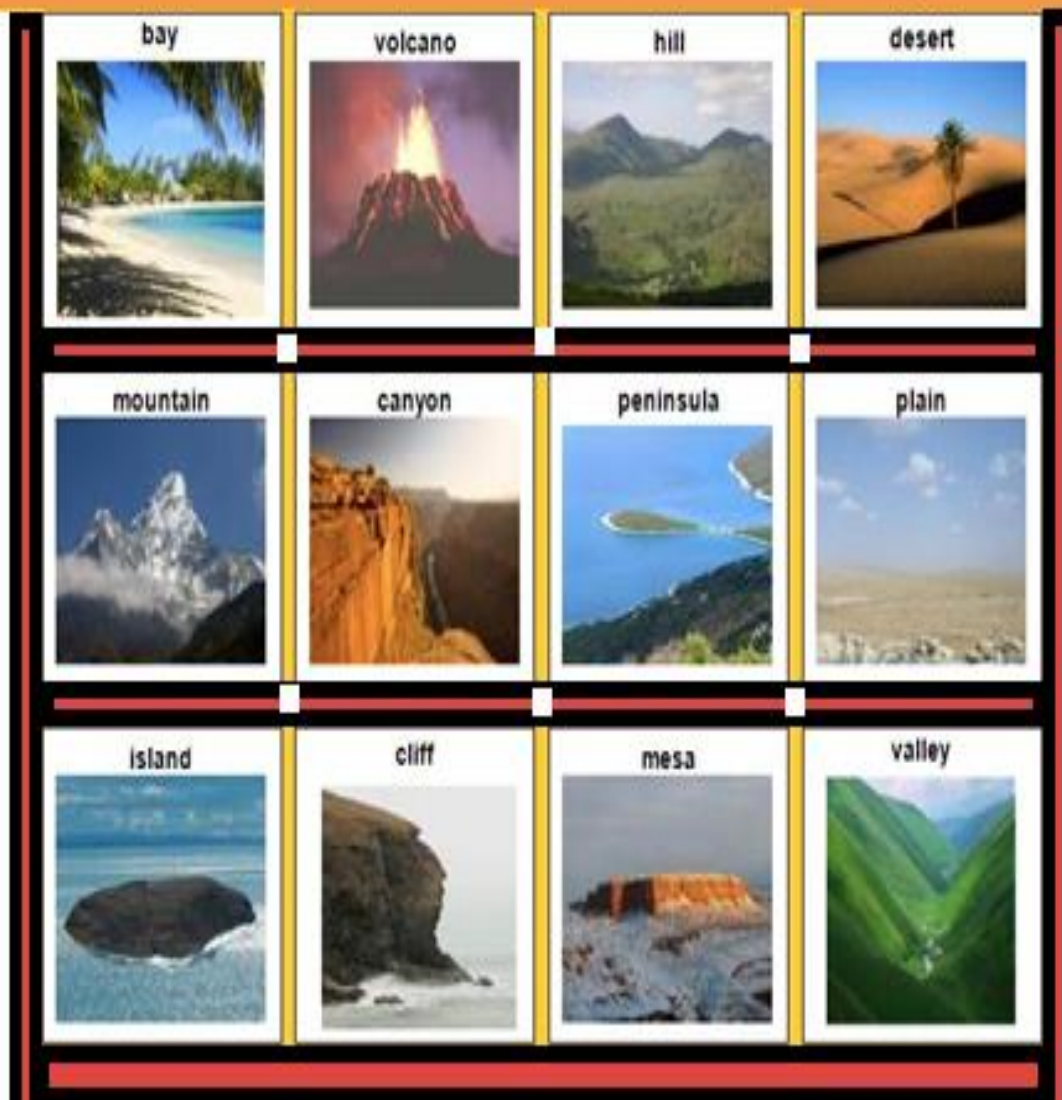

Types of Landforms

Landforms vary greatly in size and shape-from level plains to high mountain peaks. We will be learning about three main types of land forms: mountains, plains, and plateaus.



PLATEAU

- **Plateaus** are landforms that are found in mountain regions.
- Plateaus often come off of mountains.
- The Great Plains are located on a plateau that comes off the Rocky Mountains.

A valley is a hollow or surface depression of the earth bounded by hills or mountains, a natural trough in the earth's surface, that slopes down to a stream, lake or the ocean, formed by water and/or ice erosion.

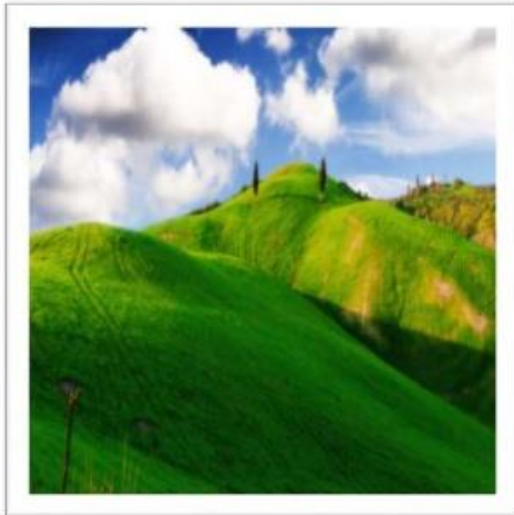


A river is a body of fresh water flowing through a channel to the sea or ocean. Click to view video below

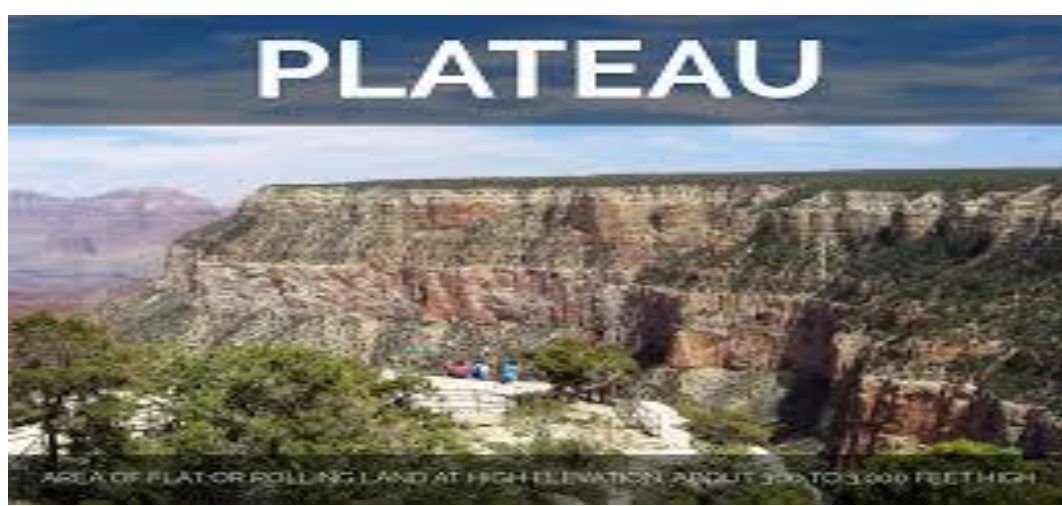

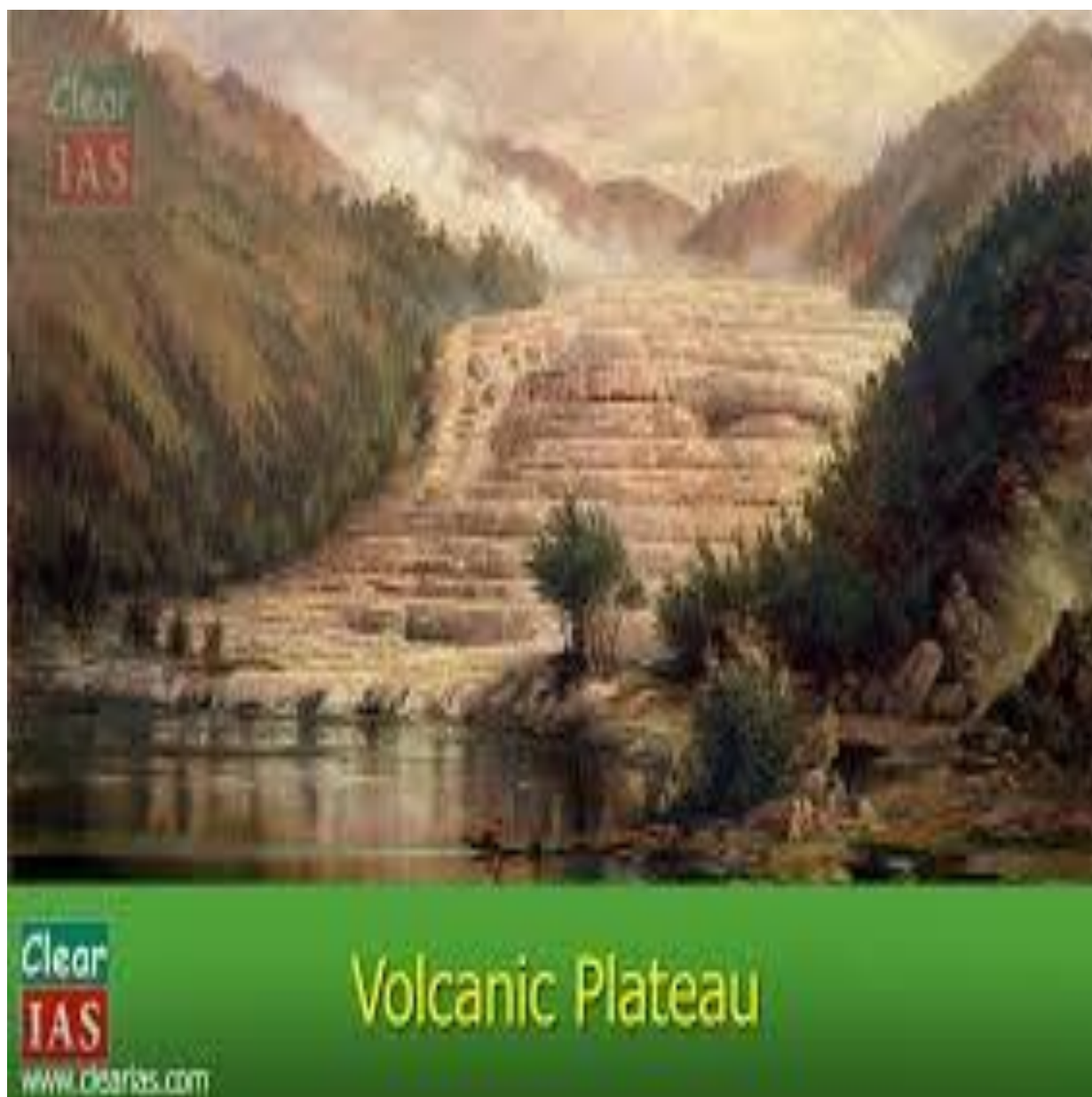

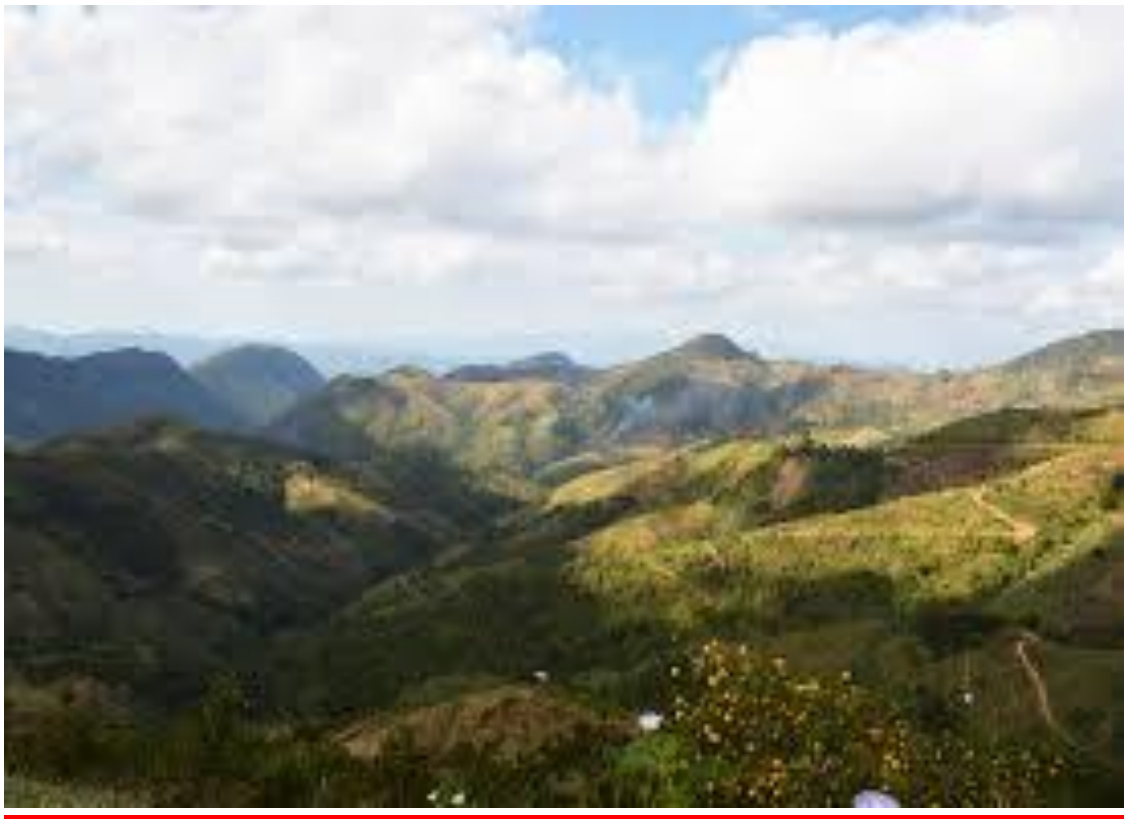

Three-dimensional depiction of geomorphic components of mountains.

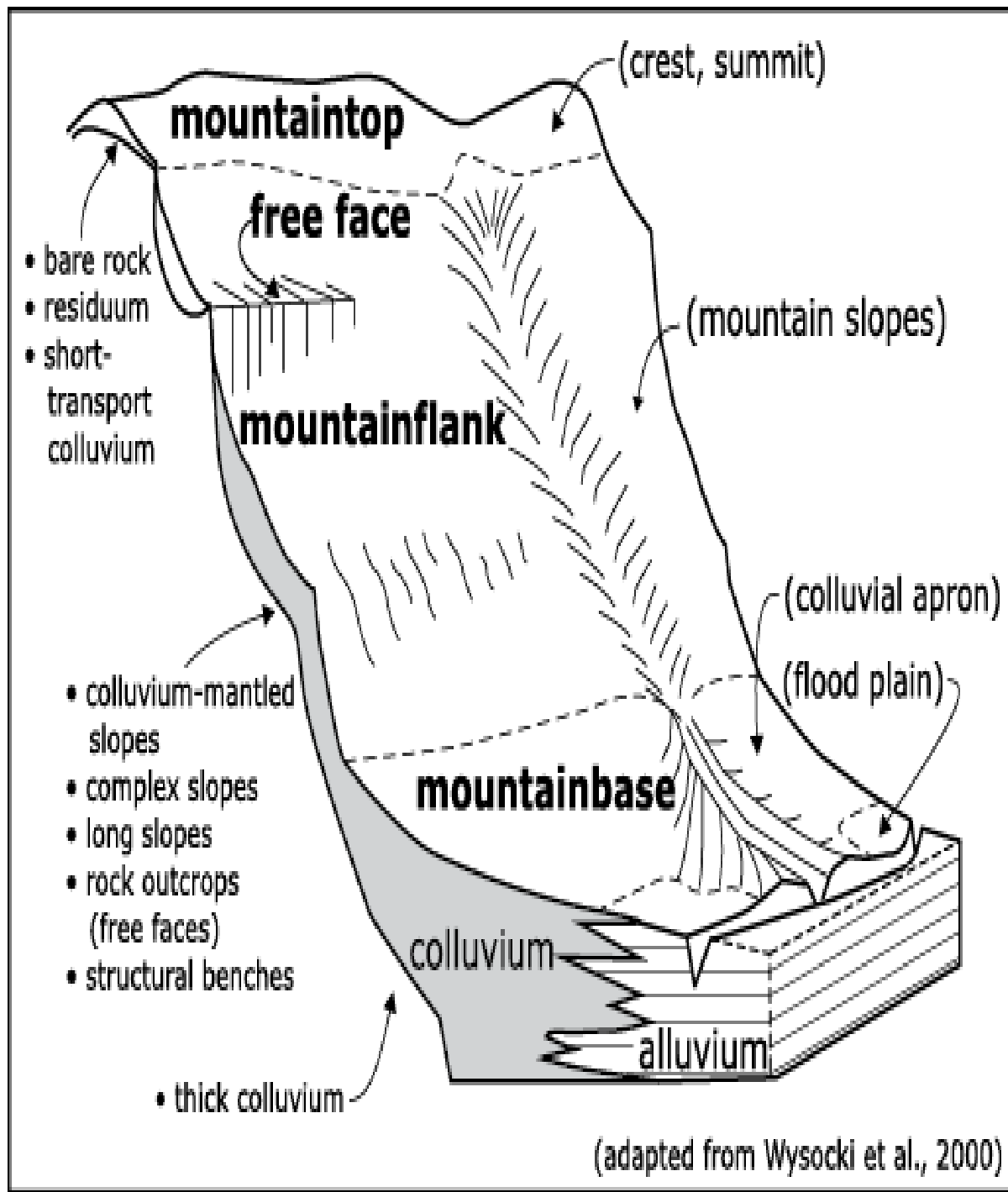
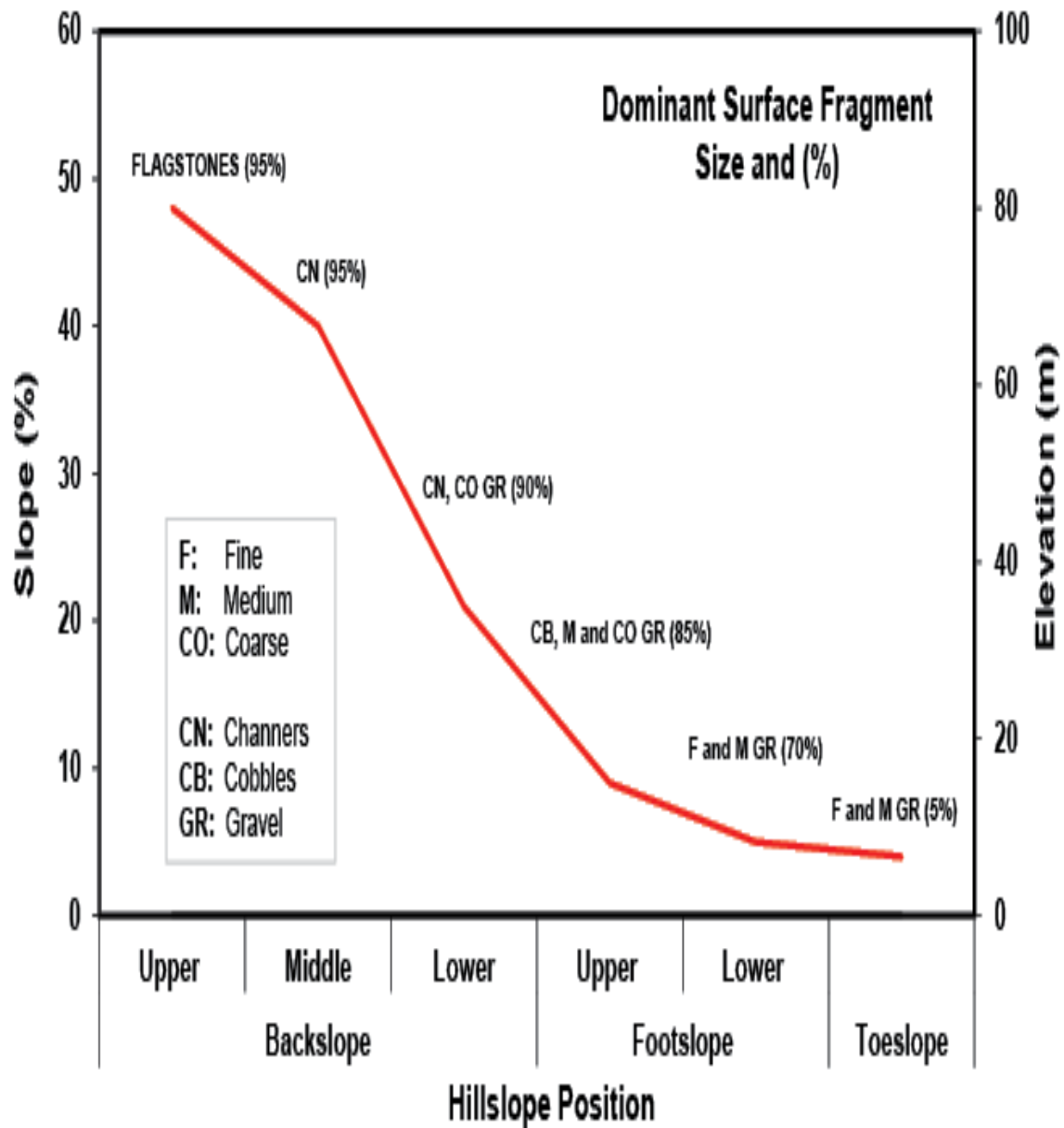
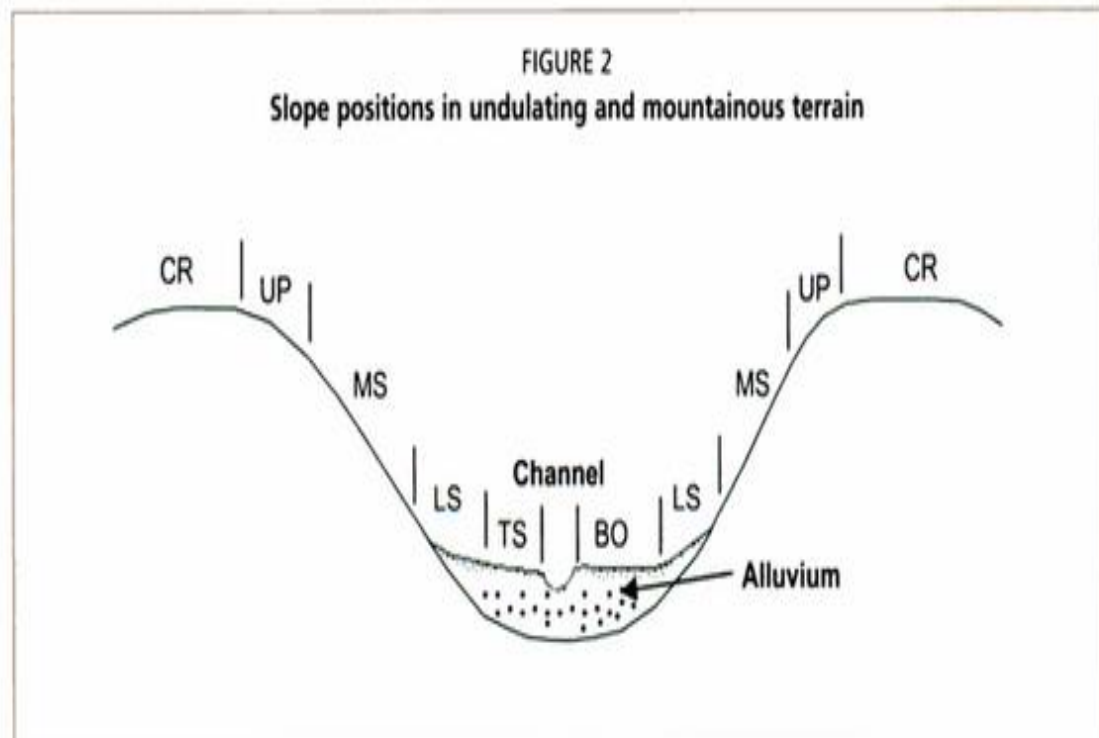
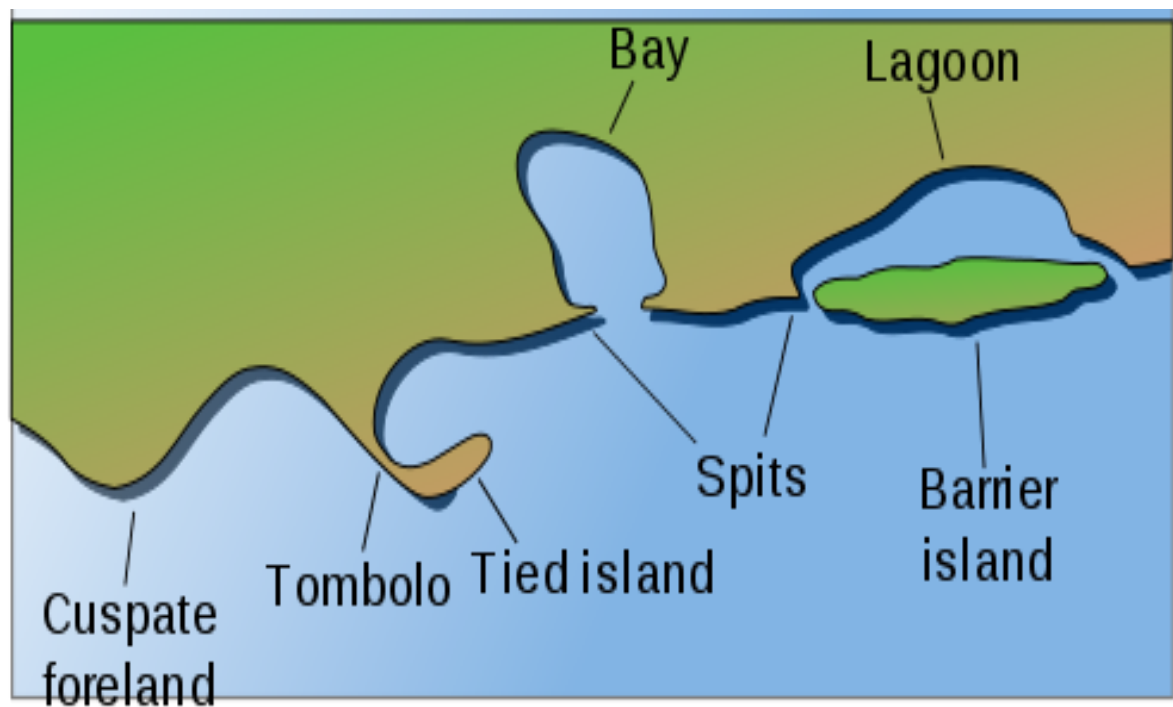


Diagram of the change in surface fragments along a transect of

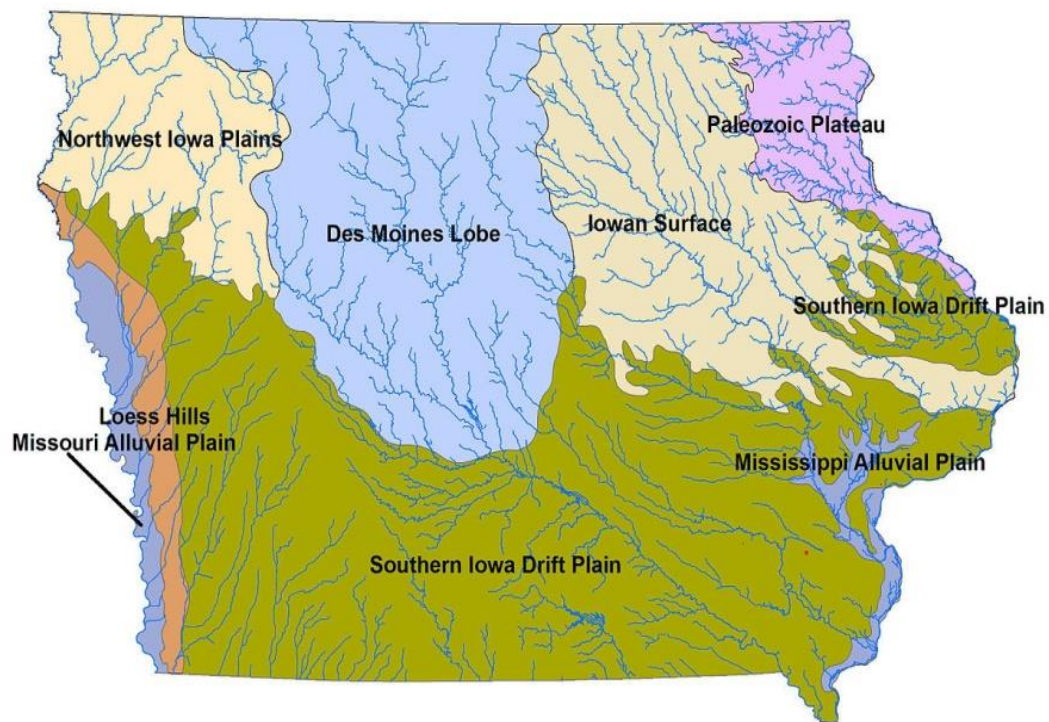




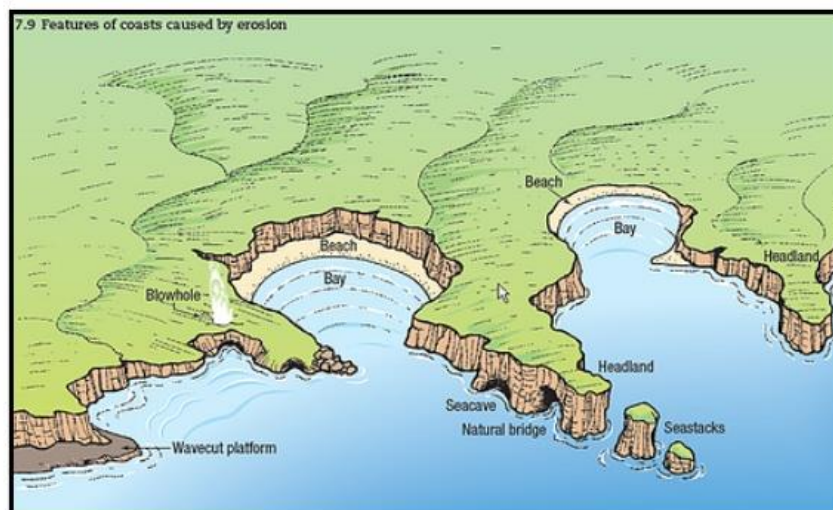

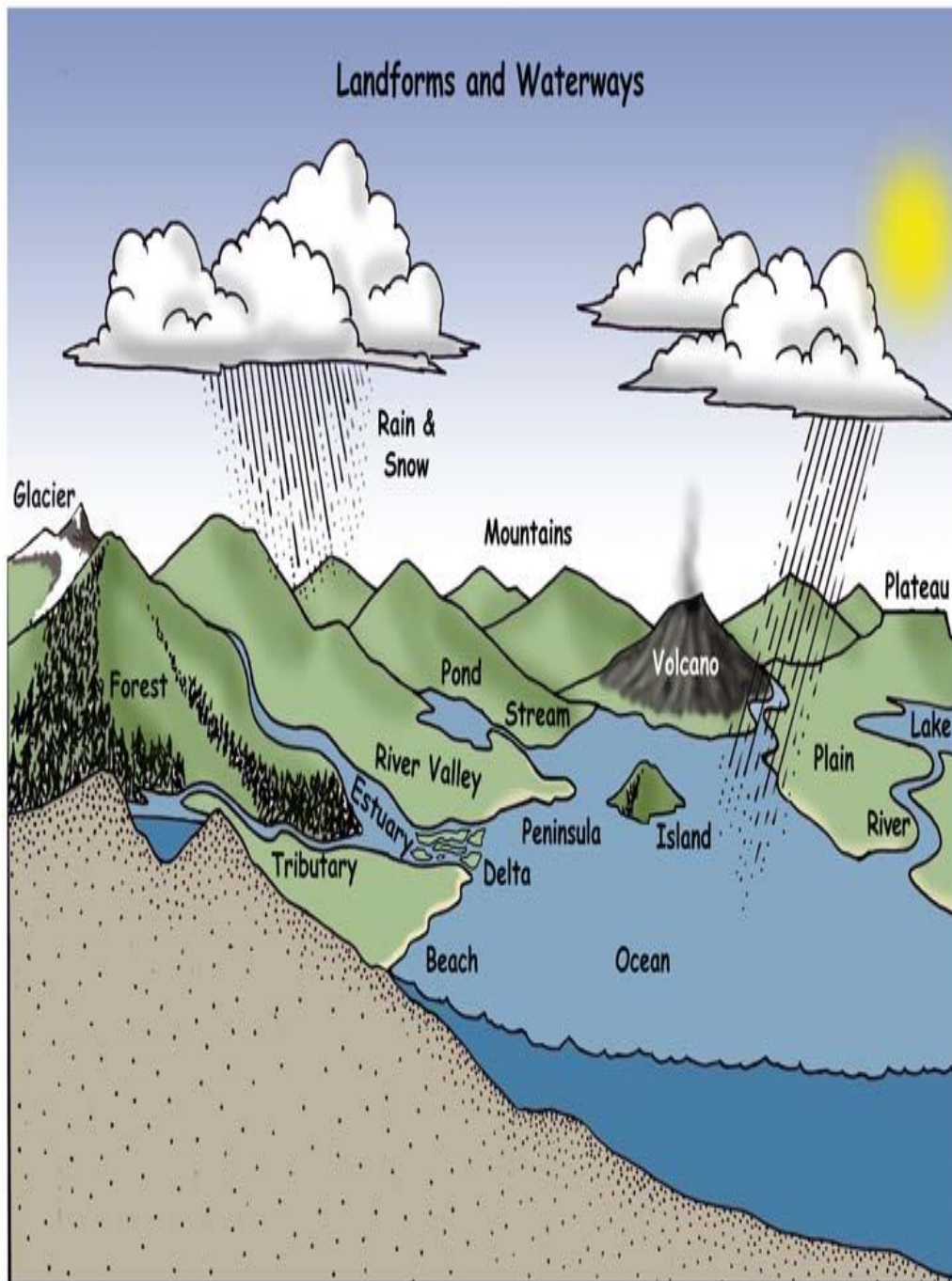
