WORK ATMOSPHERE:

The cardiology department in Cairo University hospitals is one of the most busy and expanding departments. It is a tertiary referral center for different cardiac diseases. With a total capacity of 120 beds, it serves over 9000 inpatients per year. It contains 3 cath labs and 1 EP lab performing over 3000 procedures per year. Procedures performed include coronary, peripheral and carotid interventions, balloon valvuloplasty, cardiac catheterization for congenital heart disease, EP studies, ablation and devices implantation.

ELECTROPHYSIOLOGY TRAINING:

Since Jan, 2008 First assistant then primary operator in **EP procedures including AF ablation using 3D mapping system and device implantation including CRT device implantation** at Cairo University, Cairo, Egypt.

Actively participating in Pacemaker /Arrhythmia clinic at Cairo University hospital where we examine about 15 patients either having devices implanted including CRTs and ICDs and coming for follow up visits or having tachyarrhythmias to decide what is the best for them.

Feb, 2013- Feb, 2014 EHRA Training Fellowship Programme "Advanced Clinical Electrophysiology with emphasis on Catheter Ablation" at the Department of Cardiology, Institute of Clinical and Experimental Medicine (IKEM), Prague, Czech Republic under supervision of Prof. Josef Kautzner.

During this fellowship I actively participated, in more than 307 procedures (160 atrial fibrillation ablation, 24 atrial tachycardia, 29 typical atrial flutter, 27 paroxysmal SVT, 25 VT ablation, 24 ectopy ablation, 11 AVN ablation and 7 diagnostic procedures). In addition, I had observed almost the same number of procedures.

I was also able to observe different implantation procedures including pacemakers, defibrillators and biventricular devices at the implantation room.
