Sherif Hussein is a lecturer of general, laparoscopic and vascular surgery in Kasr El-Aini Faculty of medicine, Cairo University, Egypt. The Kasr El-Aini Faculty of Medicine Cairo University is one of the oldest and largest medical schools in the Middle East, harboring close to 3,500 beds and receiving referrals from all over the country. The department of surgery is divided into 14 units, each having around 40 beds. Each unit has a special interest in a subspecialty of surgery, including plastic, vascular, laparoscopic, pediatric, trauma and endocrine surgery.

He graduated from Cairo University in November 2002 with the degree of "Excellent with honors". He then spent **one** year as a house officer, where he rotates in 2 months shifts in the different departments (Surgery, Internal medicine, Pediatrics, Obs&Gyn, Orthopedics and A&E departments). He then spent **three** years as a resident of general and vascular surgery at the Cairo University Hospitals, from March 2004 to March 2007, during which he obtained his Master's degree (M.Sc). As part of his master's degree, he completed a thesis titled "Open surgical management of infra renal Aortic aneurysm". The M.Sc degree entitles its beholder to be titled a "specialist" in his field. During his residency, he spent 28 months in the unit of *Vascular and General Surgery*, and **9** months in the **causality** department.

Following his residency, he worked as an assistant lecturer in the Vascular Surgery Unit, Department of Surgery at the Cairo University School of Medicine. The duties in the department included performing and assisting in surgical procedures, supervising the work of residents and house officers, managing in-patients and follow up of patients in the outpatient clinic, giving tutorial classes to final year medical students and attending and presenting case studies during the conferences held at the surgery department. The assistant lecturer position is a continuation of one's training program, and the duties of a clinical demonstrator are very similar to those of a fellow in the USA.

He works part time as a surgical specialist at the New Kasr El Aini French Teaching Hospital and since completing his residency, he has assisted several of the surgery professors in their private practice.

** The resident is required to finish 36 months of residency in the department units. Duties include*

1. A weekly outpatient clinic, where the resident is expected to see over 40 patients a day and refer selected cases to the senior staff.
2. Care for inpatients including the history taking, examination, continuous supervision and preparation for surgery.
3. Prepare and present the staff rounds three times weekly.
4. Assist in the surgeries done for the patients, and perform surgeries himself, both assisted and later under supervision. This averages 12-20 surgeries a week.
5. Every 12 weeks, the resident and his unit are in charge of all surgeries performed in the ER department for one week. This averages 80-100 surgeries in a week.

6. Present case studies at scientific meetings held in the department
7. Attend postgraduate lectures in Surgery (Part One and Two of the Surgery Course)
8. Research on his master's thesis.
9. Organise the undergraduate tutorial and clinical classes for the medical students.
10. A 9 months shift in the ER department, where the resident is the first to meet patients in the ER department and provides resuscitation to casualty patients.

Duties of clinical demonstrator include

- Perform different vascular and general surgical procedures and assist both residents and more senior staff in surgeries.
- Twice weekly tutorial and clinical classes to final year medical students.
- Regular assessment and education of the medical students in the unit, including demonstration of surgeries and radiology classes.
- Supervision of written exams for final year medical students and assistance in their marking.
- Preparation of oral and clinical exams for the final year medical students.
- Attending the postgraduate lectures and courses organized by the department.
- Regular rounds on in patients.
- Supervise the outpatient clinic, supervising the work of the residents and seeing patients himself.
- Supervising the work of house officers

- Preparing and presenting case studies during the conferences held regularly at the surgery department.

Once the candidate passes the first part, he is allowed to enter the second part. The second part includes preparation of an essay and a final exam. The final exam includes a written examination in the different branches of surgery, i.e. general, plastic, vascular, emergency, neurosurgical and cardiothoracic, plus oral exams in clinical and operative surgery, radiology and anatomical spotting.

Performed over 100 hernia operations, 40 thyroidectomies, 40 open cholecystectomies, 3 submandibular sialadenectomies, 200 appendicectomies, 30 mastectomies, 200 amputations (BKA & AKA), 40 splenectomies, and 100 exploratory laparotomy for trauma, 50 exploratory laparotomy for peritonitis /intestinal obstruction, 15 colectomies, 10 laparoscopic cholecystectomies, and 60 anal procedures.

Assisted in a large number of general surgical procedures including, for example over 100 laparoscopic cholecystectomies, 30 colectomies, 5 abdominoperineal resections, 10 oesophagectomies, 5 block neck dissections and 150 exploratory laparotomy for trauma or peritonitis.
