## **JOB DESCRIPTION**

  - Measurement of cardiac output by thermodilution techniques.
  - Pericardiocentesis, pleural and peritoneal tapping.
  - Pacing techniques (temporary).

  - Bedside diagnostic transthoracic echo-cardiography.
  - Bronchoscopic endotracheal intubation.
  - Treatment of different types of cardiac arrhythmias.
  - Treatment of different acid-base and electrolyte disturbances.
  - Chest tube insertion and removal.
  - Management of post operative cases with major surgical procedures.
  - Management of different medical non-surgical cases.
