The Egyptian Society of Animal Production (ESAP) will organize the conference on the occasion of the society's 50th anniversary under the general theme "Animal production for poverty alleviation in tropics and sub-tropical areas"

1. Tentative Program

- The scientific program will include three general sessions, in addition to the scientific sessions. The general sessions will discuss three issues:
 - 1. Potentialities of livestock Genetic Resources in Arab countries, the Mediterranean and Africa
 - 2. Prospects of Application of Molecular Genetics in Animal Production Enhancement.
 - 3. Buffalo Genomics, Recognition and Applications.
- The scientific sessions will cover the disciplines of genetics, physiology, nutrition, production systems, management and animal welfare as well as veterinary aspects of livestock including poultry, camels and fish.
- The program will also include poster session(s). ESAP will provide three awards for the best three posters by young researchers.
- English is the official language for scientific papers during the scientific sessions.
- Presentation of scientific papers will be through theater format or via poster.
- The program will also include social events for the participants and their accompanying persons.
