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Title of Thesis: Behaviors that Children acquire from The Egyptian Films which broadcasting on Satellite Channels (Study on a Sample of Fathers and Mothers)

Summary: This study aims to identify to what extent children acquire behaviors from The Egyptian Films which broadcasting on Satellite Channels, The kind of behaviors which acquire and The variables which control Films' impacts on children. in addition to knowing parents' estimating the impact of these Films on their children and the extent of the parental mediation.

The research has adopted in this study on The Survey method on a Random Sample of 400 individual members of fathers and mothers whose have children their age range between 6-12 years old from Cairo and Giza governorates.

The results: There is a significant correlation between the intensity of child's television viewing of Egyptian Films which broadcasting on Satellite Channels and his acquisition of behaviors in general from these films. The most significant negative behaviors acquired by children are: The films make the child asks about topics not appropriate to his age, The child is suffering from cases of anxiety and fear as a result of watching some films and The child learn some violent and risky movements. The main positive behaviors are: The child likes charity works and learn how to treat with others. The restrictive mediation is the most pattern of parental mediation using by parents, then co-viewing, then active mediation (discussion).
