Third: Philosophy of teaching and scientific research

The philosophy of teaching and scientific research of Dr. Mohammed Mahmoud Youssif is based on the combination of theory and application by teaching, explaining and analyzing economic theories and literature for concepts such as the concepts of sustainable development - real estate investment - economic sustainability - knowledge economy - sustainable urban development and various economic concepts. Then the researcher follows practical experiences of these Concepts applied to Arab and foreign countries.

The philosophy of teaching and scientific research is also based on the importance of analysis and measurement by clarifying the importance and indicators used to measure the phenomenon such as indicators of the feasibility study - indicators for evaluating real estate investment - traditional economic indicators at the macro level - indicators related to the field of urban economy such as indicators of market cities and factories - indicators of investment in land - Indicators of the industrial economic base in existing and new cities - Indicators of housing economics such as the real estate developer's profit, break-even analysis and balance of the real estate market and indicators of the input and output schedule in the real estate market - Indicators of urban financial analysis.

The teaching philosophy is also based on the importance of the student participating in answering some questions, asking questions or expressing opinions on certain concepts, and the importance of conducting research on issues and concepts related to the topics of the study.

The philosophy of teaching and scientific research is also based on the continuous updating of course descriptions by adding new, emerging elements, and scientific research is also done using modern sources and modern applied scientific experiments as well.

The philosophy of teaching courses is based on a combination of e-learning and direct instruction in the classroom. There is extensive experience in
