Dr. Fahmy is a graduate of Cairo University School of Medicine and trained in Cairo University Hospitals since 1991 then trained and became an Alumnus from Cleveland Clinic, Cleveland, Ohio in 2007. Similarly, he has a great interest in Cardiac Electrophysiology including non-invasive arrhythmia and syncope diagnosis, and invasive cardiac arrhythmia ablation especially Atrial Fibrillation and Ventricular tachycardia.

Dr. Fahmy is the Secretary General of Egyptian Cardiac Rhythm Association, member of the European Heart Rhythm Association, and a founding member of the Egyptian College of Critical Care Physicians.
